Our Mission:

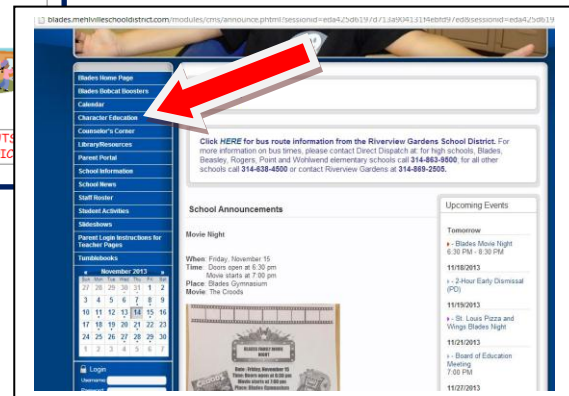
The mission of Blades Elementary School is to prepare our students to become self-confident, responsible citizens by providing a strong academic foundation in a caring community.
