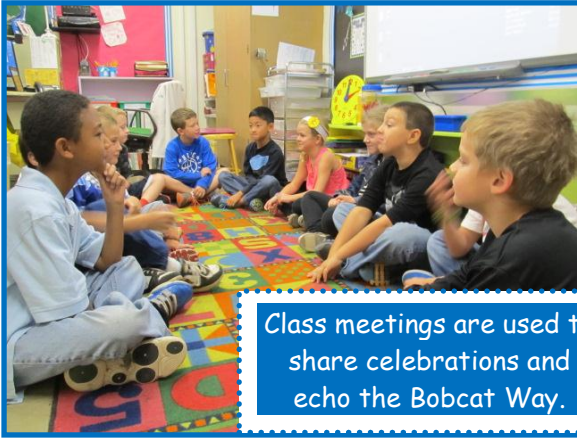




Blades Elementary School Principle 2



Class meetings are used to share celebrations and echo the Bobcat Way.

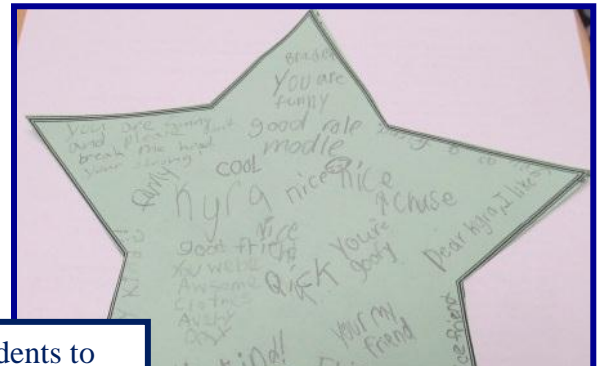

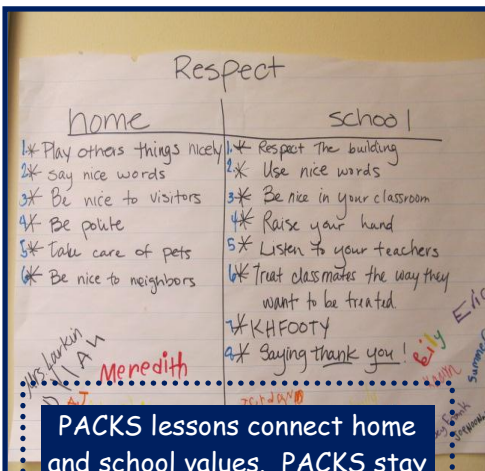


"After school I go to Girls on The Run. It is only for girls. We have lots of fun but can be serious when we need to. I really enjoy meeting with the girls and want to do it again."
